CODE OF CONDUCT February 25, 2020

Code Affirmation:

- 1. The objective of the Little Brown Jug Square Dancers Code of Conduct is to promote sociability, good fellowship, and contemporary western square dancing for its members and guests at all activities. It is the Club intention to extend courtesy, respect, and friendliness to all.**
- 2. Little Brown Jug Square Dancers do not discriminate or refuse membership or participation based on race, color, religion, gender, sexual preference, national origin, age, ancestry, or disability.**

Code Misconduct:

- 1. Misconduct is defined as behavior which is in violation of existing laws/regulations which are in effect in the community and are contrary to the safety or welfare of Club members or which threatens the smooth operation of Club activities.**
- 2. Specific Prohibitions:**
 - a. Angry or vulgar language, including swearing or name calling.**
 - b. Physical contact with anyone in any angry, threatening, or unwanted way.**
 - c. Harassment or intimidation by words, gestures, facial expression, body language, communication devices, or any other offensive behavior.**
 - d. Reeking of alcohol**
- 3. All members and guests are expected to adhere to this Code of Conduct which is also posted on the Little Brown Jug Square Dancers website. A copy is issued to new club members and to all members upon any change in the constitution.**

The Executive Committee:

May remove any person from attendance at Little Brown Jug dances, classes, or club activities for reasons of misconduct that occur at any square dance activity, or through community harassment.

- 1. Members/guests who repeatedly refuse to follow this Code will be asked to leave the activity by the club President and one other Committee member if necessary.**
- 2. Should the President and/or at least one other Committee member feel the offense warrants assistance from local law enforcement, they have the approval of the club to summon the police.**
